AMBERSENT was well placed saving ground off the dueling leaders to the stretch, split horses while rallying in midstretch and inched clear late under urging. EMILY'S ATTITUDE dueled for the lead from between horses to the stretch, continued willingly through the lane but proved no match for the winner late. MISS FROSTY TAIL raced three wide in the second flight and outside of the winner on the turn, rallied strongly to get on even terms a furlong out but flattened out late. TEMPTOR BUILDER broke a step slow, saved ground while advancing on the turn, angled out approaching the stretch and had a mild rally without threatening. ZUDORA JANE raced well back to the stretch before passing tired rivals. TARESE RIVER also passed tired foes through the lane without threatening. DUCHESS SARA vied for the lead from between horses on the backstretch before dropping back approaching the turn. DUNCAN MISS showed little. HONEST TILT raced four wide on the turn and was never a factor. PASSTELL WOODS broke sharply to show in front early, dueled for the lead while three wide to the stretch before tiring. MISS O'BRANNIGAN came out a bit leaving the gate and was always outrun. PROFESSIONAL GIRL

dueled for the lead along the rail to the stretch before tiring badly.
