Footnotes

PRAIRE COUGAR vied for the early lead with SACRED ROMANCE and AVALANCHE PASS, continued to match strides with rivals heading into the stretch, edged up at the five sixteenth marker to take a slight lead, dug in and drew clear. SACRED ROMANCE dueled with PRAIRE COUGAR and AVALANCHE PASS while racing along the outside of rivals, continued to match strides with PRAIRE COUGAR in the upper stretch but could not sustain bid in the late drive. DAZZLING PIONEER raced in the back of rivals early, made a five wide bid in the stretch turn and steadily gained ground in the drive. HERE COMES POLLY stalked the early front runners, saved ground along the inside and failed to rally in the late drive. AVALANCHE PASS dueled with rivals while racing near the inside, continued to match strides heading into the turn but had nothing left in the late drive. RUDY'S EDGE showed early speed and steadily faded.
