Footnotes

CORKING TULIP was unhurried while saving ground off the leaders, angled three wide entering the stretch, hit the front leaving the furlong marker and drew clear under steady left handed urging. DROWNING pressed the pace between horses early, settled into a stalking position on the backstretch, made a bid for the lead in upper stretch, proved no match for the winner but held second. ALY PERFORMER finished willingly without threatening. HAPPY IN REALITY was taken back and angled to the rail early, raced four wide on the second turn, had a mild late rally without threatening. SENORITA JUANITA set the pace while pulling hard the first half mile, was headed entering the stretch, continued willingly to midstretch before weakening late. SEY'S GLO raced four wide on the first turn and was not a factor. BLACK BACARDI raced close up while three wide, remained prominent until upper stretch before giving way. TREASURED GAL showed little. CLASSEY PEARL saved ground and was not a factor. CUPCAKE dropped back on the backstretch.
