**Footnotes**

ANSWER TO JORDAN broke a bit inward brushing TRICKLE DOWN, quickly went clear, widened entering the stretch and maintained a clear advantage to the wire under steady right handed pressure. TALKALOUD split horses while advancing entering the lane, finished willingly and was easily second best while never threatening the winner. LODESTONE chased the pace while saving ground to the stretch, finished evenly and outnodded VALID LEADER for third money. VALID LEADER stalked the winner while racing in hand to midway on the turn, failed to respond when asked entering the stretch and weakened while failing to switch leads through the lane. LIL IRENE was never a factor. VAINE OF GOLD raced three wide on the turn while within range in midpack but weakened through the stretch. TRICKLE DOWN was brushed by the winner at the start and trailed throughout.
