**Footnotes**

SOUTHERN ORDER dueled from the two path to the final quarter of a mile, went clear entering the stretch and drew off in the final furlong under urging. PAPIER MACHE settled off the dueling leaders early, maintained her position from the two path to the stretch, split rivals a sixteenth out, finished willingly and gained the place in the final stride. PNUTBUTTERANDJOLIE dueled along the rail to the stretch, weakened through the final furlong and lost second at the wire. ONDA RAY saved ground racing well back to the stretch, angled out in upper stretch and failed to rally. BROKE TRYING stalked the pace racing three wide to the stretch before tiring. JAZZY GEM broke outward, trailed throughout.
