DRESS BLUES stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded along the rail to gain a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. MIKALAH FAITH dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained forward entering the drive but could not keep pace. FATHER'S GLAMOUR chased the early pace from between foes, made a bid entering the drive and finished well. KEYLESS up close early while inside, made a bid entering the stretch but could not sustain the effort. CURRENT TOPIC chased the early pace from the outside but had nothing left for the drive. PHOEBE'S TUNE broke awkward and was no factor. CREME LEA was no threat. CART'S FORTY NINE dueled from the outside and tired.
