HOLLYWOOD AND WINE settled off the early pacesetters, saved ground on the turn, came through inside rivals to challenge in midstretch and drew off under urging. DIS MISS dueled from the two path to midstretch, continued willingly and saved the place. THIS ONE FOR ABBEY chased the pace racing three wide to the stretch, rallied to loom a threat in upper stretch before flattening out late. WALKS LIK'N ANGEL dueled along the rail to the stretch, drifted out entering the lane and weakened. K. O. PHYLLIS vied from between rivals early, chased racing near the inside to the stretch before weakening. EXANASTASIS was never a factor. SHARKEY'S GOLD was outrun.
