RUNAWAY ELAINEY bore out at the start and bumped WAPSI WOMAN, raced in a good striking position behind the dueling quartet, took over when swung six wide in the stretch and responded to right-handed pressure to prevail. BRIGHT N BREEZY broke alertly, was taken back and conserved, lodged a solid seven wide bid in the stretch and was gaining gradually. MACKEES LAST TRICK dueled for the early lead while five wide, tired a bit late but managed to hold on for the show. SILENTPAT prompted the pace while racing closest to the rail but faltered in deep stretch. YUXON GOLD pressed the pace between rivals and gave way in the final furlong. WAPSI WOMAN was bumped at the start by the eventual winner and showed little thereafter. CARSON'S CROSSING vied for the early lead while racing four wide and retreated during the stretch run.
