BLUE BOY BLUE gained the lead, held well into the stretch and drew off under steady pressure. CHARLIE JOHN raced forwardly while three wide, remained three wide into the stretch, proved no match but kept on. TEA PARTY CAMPAIGN saved ground, veered out at the seven-sixteenths marker and failed to menace. KELA WAY settled, was hampered at the seven-sixteenths marker, had to be snatched up as a result and had no rally. BIG MAN ON CAMPUS chased the pace while four wide and faded. PATTI'S DANCER was always outrun. FOLLOWING THE RACE, THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO AN INCIDENT AT THE SEVEN-SIXTEENTHS MARKER. AFTER REVIEWING VIDEO TAPED REPLAYS, THEY DISQUALIFIED TEA PARTY CAMPAIGN FOR INTERFERENCE AND PLACED HIM FOURTH.
