DEVIL ON THE RUN sprinted clear early, widened a bit while under a rating hold on the backstretch, kicked away when asked in upper stretch and prevailed under an aggressive hand ride. ARKANSAS QUEEN stalked the winner to the stretch, couldn't keep pace entering the lane but gamely saved second. PERSONAL DREAM settled along the rail early, angled out while moving up midway on the second turn, finished evenly and just missed second. MEAN JEAN IPOCK trailed for the first half mile, remained well back to the stretch before passing several tired rivals. ANNIANO raced within striking range from the two path to the stretch before giving way. SEQUOIA ROSE stumbled leaving the gate but recovered quickly, raced within range near the inside in midpack to the stretch before tiring. SPLASH TOUR was well back to the second turn, raced erratically entering the bend and was outrun. READY AT NOON was outrun. KISSIN BY EM raced three wide in midpack to the second turn, stopped.
