Footnotes

BUCK'S APPEAL raced along the rail in midpack to the stretch, rallied willingly from between rivals in the final furlong and got up at the wire. SMOKE MOUNTAIN dueled along the rail to the stretch, inched clear in upper stretch, continued willingly but was narrowly outfinished. SPEED ROUSER tracked the pacesetters to the final turn, angled out four wide early on the bend, rallied outside rivals to challenge in the final sixteenth but was outfinished by the top pair. CLEARTHEPATH raced three wide while advancing on the first turn, dueled outside of the runner up down the backstretch and around the final turn, weakened through the lane. SPRING TRAINING was unhurried racing well off the pace from the two path, moved closer entering the lane, was blocked and forced to steady off heels in midstretch, altered course to the inside and failed to rally when clear. COLORADO JAZZ settled well off the early pace, moved closer while hung out five wide on the final turn, failed to produce a late bid. KILATES KISS showed little while racing inside. GOOD OFFER pressed the pace from between rivals on the first turn, remained a forward factor to the stretch before tiring. SWISS RESERVE trailed throughout.
