VISIONS IN COLOR settled while racing seven wide up the backstretch, edged closer on the far turn, moved seven wide into the stretch and rallied determinedly to get up in the final strides. DON'T JINX IT set a well-measured pace, held on gamely through the stretch but was pegged back. THRILL OF VICTORY saved ground in mid-pack and lodged a mild bid while racing along the inside. I'M BLUFFING stalked the pace but was outfinished by the principles. PRIVATE WAGER was void of early speed yet managed to pass tiring rivals. SHORTY SMALL raced in the first flight but found little in the stretch run. MOCKINGBIRD LANE was forwardly placed but faltered through the stretch run. STACK BLUES never menaced. MISTER MILLU trailed throughout.
