FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. Three-year-olds - 118 lbs.; Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$25,000 twice other than maiden or claiming in 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; non-winners of \$20,000 once or \$12,000 twice other than maiden or claiming in 2012 allowed 5 lbs.; \$15,000 once or \$10,000 twice other than maiden or claiming in 2012 allowed 7 lbs.; \$9,000 once other than maiden or claiming in 2012 allowed 9 lbs. No nomination fee. \$350 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start. \$60,000 guaranteed of which 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth. SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATIONS AT TIME OF ENTRY WITH A FEE OF \$1,200 TO ENTER AND START. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds twelve (12), high weights will be preferred. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second parts of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees.

RIVER BEAR reserved early, advanced leaving the turn, angled out five wide approaching the furlong marker and rallied strongly under firm handling. SIGNSEALNDELIVER settled well, commenced his bid on the turn, moved four wide into the stretch, stayed on, led but was reeled in late. WIREFORTWOTWENTY prompted the pace, edged clear into the stretch but was worn down late. OUTTA TUNE carried in a bit at the start, was outpaced, entered the stretch three wide and posed no threat. BILLY TWO HATS brushed at the start, chased the pace and lacked the needed kick. CITY SAGE veered in at the start, was hustled along early, dueled and gave way.
