BLUEBIRD QUARTET gained the early lead, relinquished her advantage on the turn while confidently handled, responded to rousing at the three-sixteenths marker and kicked clear readily. DREAMS ON THE WIND stalked the pace, moved to the front on the turn, proved no match but kept on to secure the place spot. PHILLYONTHEEDGE reserved early, swung five wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. SPANK ME HAPPY saved ground and lacked a rally. CAROL'S GIFT chased the pace while five wide, advanced on the turn and flattened out in the stretch. BAG THE STORM veered out at the start and was never a factor.
