KNOTHEAD WILL bumped at the start, stumbled as a result, dropped far back, advanced into a contending position on the far turn, waited for room along the inside in the stretch, got through approaching the furlong marker when full of run and was going away at the finish. DODGE THE BULLET saved ground, angled off the rail for the stretch run and stayed on. OUR REUBEN set a contested pace, held well into the stretch and was worn down late. LAKE LUCERNE settled well, lodged a brief bid on the far turn and flattened out in the stretch. BE LIKE MS. D. chased the pace while four wide and gave no response when called upon. BIG RAH forced the pace and faded. G FROST was outrun.
