INCIDENTAL AFFAIR forwardly placed between rivals, entered the stretch three wide, angled in at the furlong marker, responded to pressure and seized command late. FLOODGATE reserved early, commenced his four wide bid around the turn, continued four wide into the stretch and stayed on well to snare the place in the final strides. J P CAMPBELL grabbed the early lead, forged clear into the stretch and was worn down in the last sixteenth. MA'S BATTLE outpaced early, advanced while five wide on the turn, remained five wide for the stretch run and produced a mild bid. FRASER was forwardly placed along the inside and gave no response. AMBER BOY proved no factor. BUCKS SON never menaced. WERRABRAVECYCLONE flashed brief speed and retreated.
