BAXTER CODE gained the lead, was headed leaving the turn and yielded. LAUNCH LIGHT LADY raced forwardly between rivals and lacked a rally. INDIAN STAR saved ground and failed to menace. CRESCO HIFLYER was always outrun. SUNNY SHARK was void of speed and proved no factor. INDIAN DREAM forced the pace and faltered.
