HARD SEVEN stalked the early pace from the inside, altered outside entering the turn, gained the advantage and steadily drew clear. DIANE'S GREY DAWN broke well from the outside to duel for the early lead, remained forward through the drive but could not keep pace. SWEET TIZZY LIZZY dueled from the inside early, remained in a forward position entering the drive but was no match late. JUDGE THIS chased the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the drive but was too late. CAROL'S FRIEND could only pass tired ones. LEXI'S READY chased the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. DIAMOND STAR went evenly. JEFFELL was no factor. KEEPER HUMBLE never threatened. BANGO TANGO showed little.
