DEMIDOFFLIGHT raced in striking position early, moved up to duel on the turn, responded to brisk pressure and wore down his stable mate. HERE'S A CLU duelled, was urged on the turn, dug in gamely in the stretch run but missed. SHARK'S DELIGHT reserved, was angled in entering the stretch and stayed on. SWEDEVILLE settled well and showed some mild late interest. WHISPER TO JACK veered out at the start, was outpaced while four wide and made no contending bid. DOJI BOY prompted the pace and dropped back on the turn. DIXIE SURGE was pinched back at the start, recovered, assumed a forward position on the turn and tired in the stretch. SIR RICHEY was always outrun. BOZO showed little. J. R. KIPPER was in tight in the early stages and was never a factor.
