CROSS HAMMERS raced in striking position while three wide, was urged on the turn, remained three wide for the stretch run and finished evenly. LOUIE THE LIP unruly before the start, was reserved, moved four wide into the stretch and kept on. BULLERO showed some mild late interest. MAC'S SURPRISE was brushed at the start and took no part.
