Footnotes

THIS ONE FOR ABBEY was unhurried early, raced well back to the stretch, rallied strongly through the final furlong, split horses late and was up at the wire to narrowly prevail under urging. HOLLYWOOD AND WINE raced close up early, slipped back a bit on the backstretch, was three deep on the final turn, rallied willingly through the lane, stuck a head in front outside rivals nearing the wire, shifted in a bit while racing on her inside lead and just missed. SOLE OF THE CITY sprinted clear early, set the pace in hand to the final turn, opened up a commanding advantage on the bend, remained well clear to midstretch, shortened stride late and was caught in the final yards. SECRET PACKAGE chased the loose leader to the stretch but failed to produce a rally. TAYLOR J raced well back, was steadied racing near the inside on the final turn while appearing to want to get out, never a factor. BUTTER CRUNCH raced in midpack near the inside to the final turn before dropping back.
