WATOMGO stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded to pressure when engaged from the outside by SEAL OF THE PEARL, dueled with that one through the drive and prevailed in the two thousandth win for the rider. SEAL OF THE PEARL close up from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, made a bid to duel through the drive but was outfinished. IDE RATHER BE LUCK broke well from the inside to gain the early margin, remained clear up the backstretch but could not keep pace. EXTINGUISHED unhurried early while inside rivals, advanced entering the second turn and finished well but too late. EASYONTHEEYES was no factor. KONA KID was no threat. SCOTTS BISQUIT chased the early pace from the outside and tired. OUTLAW AT LARGE forced the early pace and tired.
