Footnotes

MY WIRE stalked the early pacesetters, made a bid heading into the turn, raced along the outside of rivals in the stretch and was up in time to prevail. CACTUS TOWN vied with SILVERBDANCING for the lead while racing along the outside of rival, continued bid into the stretch but did not have enough late to hold off MY WIRE. OUTTA TUNE was unhurried early and raced near the back of the pack, steadily improved position and rallied strongly in the late drive and outnodded rival for show. SILVERBDANCING dueled with CACTUS TOWN racing along the inside of rival and could not keep up the pace in the late stretch. KELA'S ASSAULT raced evenly near the back of the pack and was never a threat. HIGHEST DEGREE lacked response throughout. TUFF RUFF ANDREADY made a brief bid in the early going and steadily faded.
