CASH AT NIGHT dueled with rivals racing along th outside, took command at the top of the stretch and held on to prevail. SEE ME NOW was unhurried early, made a bid heading into the turn, and rallied in the stretch. CANNON FALLS stalked the early pacesetters, raced three wide in the turn and finished evenly in the stretch. C J ROWDY raced in the back of the pack early and had a mild late gain. DUCK FIR vied between rivals in the early going and steadily weakened. WHY BE BLUE showed early speed and had nothing left late. MARGINAL RATE made a brief bid and steadily faded. HOT TOWN lacked response throughout. HOT FRANK HANK made a brief bid in the early going and faded.
