WAYZATA BAY was unhurried racing well back to the final turn, angled out five wide midway on the bend, rallied to challenge past midstretch and prevailed under urging. QUIET MONEY settled off the early leaders, rallied racing four wide on the final turn, hit the front approaching midstretch, continued willingly but could not match the winner late. THREE ELEVENS trailed to the stretch, swung out seven wide entering the lane, had a mild rally to gain third late. WILL E SCAT was forced out four wide entering the first turn, angled in on the bend, chased from the rail to the stretch, went willingly to the final furlong before weakening. PROPER CARSON bore out entering the first turn while racing on the lead, set the pace from the rail, was headed in upper stretch and weakened late. DANCE WITH LEGEND was forced out five wide entering the first turn, chased to the final turn, bid outside a rival approaching the stretch, tired late. MINGO MOHAWK raced within striking range in midpack to the stretch before giving way. CLASSIC PLAY raced in midpack from the rail to the final turn before giving way.
