JOHNNY CADILLAC stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, altered outside entering the drive, responded and wore down rivals the final furlong. BRINKER unhurried early, advanced inside up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the drive, responded along the rail but could not reach the winner. ALMAGNUS outrun early, advanced outside up the backstretch, responded when asked entering the drive and closed fast but too late. CAPE TIME dueled from the outside for the early lead, gained a clear margin up the backstretch, remained clear entering the second turn, held a clear advantage at the eighth pole but could not last. SHORTY SMALL up close early while inside, remained forward entering the drive but could not keep pace. AT THE BRINK forced the early pace from the inside but tired in the drive. HEAVEN'S HOPE could only pass tired ones. LOCOMOTION chased the early pace and tired. LIL BOBALOO was no factor. EXPLAINED had a steady fade. MERITOCRACY was finished early.
