CAINAM was well placed stalking the pace, continued to save ground along the inside, made a bid in the upper stretch, slipped thru on KATE'S MAIN MAN, took command and steadily drew clear. WEST ALBANY was unhurried early and tracked the front runners, made a bid heading into the turn, raced four wide and rallied to be up in time for place. KATE'S MAIN MAN dueled for the early lead with rivals while racing near the inside, continued to match strides every step of the way, briefly took the lead by a slight margin mid stretch until being passed by CAINUM along the inside, just missed second in final strides. WINGS OF WAR dueled between rivals from the onset, continued to match strides heading into the turn but could not keep up the pace in the late drive. LITTLE CHIEF failed to be a threat throughout. TIGER LAKE vied for the lead while racing along the outside of rivals and had nothing left in the drive.
