Footnotes

BACKWOODSMOKING dueled from between rivals on the backstretch and along the rail on the turn, kicked clear in upper stretch and widened to the wire while being kept to steady pressure. WINTER'S SHADOW raced four wide while well back on the turn, finished willingly and gained second late. CAUSE HE'S IRISH raced well off the pace from the two path to the stretch, had a mild rally and gained third late. WOOD TAK trailed to the stretch, passed tired rivals through the lane and narrowly missed the minor awards. FRENCH KISSER raced in midpack on the backstretch, made a three wide advance on the turn, weakened while failing to switch leads through the stretch. CLEARANCE DATE saved ground racing well off the pace to the stretch and was never a factor. AFLAC THE KING saved ground racing in midpack to the stretch and never threatened. CANNER dueled outside of the winner on the turn, tired through the stretch. TOMAHAWK CREEK broke slowly, rushed up inside rivals on the backstretch, chased the dueling leaders to the stretch before tiring. FLOMTASTIC flashed brief speed to vie for the lead along the rail early, stopped.
