FRAUGHT WIT DANGER reserved, moved closer on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and rallied. THUYA raced in striking position while four wide, moved five wide into the stretch and stayed on. VELVET RAGE settled well, lodged a bid on the far turn and lodged a mild bid. PAIN TOLERANCE chased along the inside and lacked a rally. SEVEN SLEWS settled while three wide and gave no response when asked. CHATTY LOU was outpaced along the inside and failed to menace. MOON'S DARK SIDE was always outrun. HALF MOUNTAIN CAT gained the lead and faded after a half mile.
