C U VATER stalked the pace, took over into the stretch and drew off readily. CHARLIE JOHN saved ground, continued inside for the stretch run, responded and kept on well. R BEST HERO off slowly, settled well, moved closer on the turn, entered the stretch three wide and stayed on. KING JIMMY chased between foes, moved four wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. AZRAELS COUNT leaned in at the start and never menaced. BIG MAN ON CAMPUS was outpaced while four wide and faded. KELA WAY chased the pace while five wide and proved no factor. TEA PARTY CAMPAIGN raced in striking position while four wide and weakened. PATTI'S DANCER gained the lead, was headed leaving the turn and faltered.
