GHAZI UP chased, entered the stretch three wide and stayed on. HAVE WE MET proved no factor. WILD SALSA DANCER gained the lead, was headed on the turn and yielded. HE CAN DO THAT failed to threaten. BITTER CREEK was outrun. TOMS PIONEER was forwardly placed and faded. HE IS QUICK was void of speed. SECRET SQUARE flashed brief speed. WHY BE BLUE faltered.
