FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. (Iowa Registered and Foaled) Iowa Bred Foals of 2009 by an Iowa Stallion that was nominated for either the 2012 Iowa Miss Stallion Stakes or the Iowa Legacy Stallion Stakes. Weight 121 lbs. Winners of a sweepstake in 2012 an additional 2 lbs.; Non-winners of a sweepstake in 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; Maidens allowed 5 lbs. Late nomination of \$15,000 will be accepted at time of entry. \$250 to pass the entry box and \$300 additional to start. \$40,000 added of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Starters to named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to start will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest lifetime earnings at the closing of entries. This preference will be utilized regardless of the ownership of those horses involved. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees.

A LITTLE EDGY reserved early, swung six wide into the stretch and rallied strongly. YOU FUNNY MAN chased along the inside, angled out four wide into the stretch, lacked room approaching the furlong marker, was maneuvered back inside and kept on. AVALANCHE PASS forced the pace, moved to the front on the turn, dug in but was worn down. GRAY EDGE raced forwardly while four wide, lodged a bid leaving the turn, was outfinished and vanned off. LAKE'S EDGE never menaced. DIABLE RIVER dueled and gave way. CHEESE BIZ was always outrun.
