Footnotes

CODING set the pace under a rating hold and without pressure to the second turn, turned away a bid from the runner up and once again went clear entering the stretch, prevailed under mild encouragement. CAVIAR EMPTOR stalked the winner from the two path to the second turn, made a brief bid outside that one approaching the stretch, continued willingly through the lane and was second best. LITTLERIVERQUEEN was taken back and angled to the rail soon after the start, made a three wide advance to reach contention on the second turn but hung through the final furlong. CRAFTY CREEK was outrun to the stretch before passing a trio of tired rivals. DANCE RHYTHM chased the top pair from the two path to midway on the second turn before tiring. SWITCH LANES was outrun. LOVESMEGOLD was very rank while pulling hard along the rail and racing just off the winner's heels on the first turn, was checked twice while continuing to fight the rider early on the backstretch, began to tire approaching the stretch and dropped back.
