DUCKY DRAKE reserved early, entered the stretch four wide, closed with a rush and was up late under solid handling. WINTER CAMP forced the pace, forged clear into the stretch, dug in gamely but was nailed late. ATTA BOY ROY settled while five wide, continued five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. VENTANA raced in striking position while four wide, lodged a bid on the turn and, despite his rider's efforts, he drifted out eight wide during the stretch run. HUMBLE SMARTY urged along early, set a contested pace, was headed on the turn and yielded. CATABOUT was off a step slow and failed to menace. BILLY TWO HATS dropped back early and was outrun.
