### Footnotes

SALTY N SASSY stalked the pace racing three wide, rallied to challenge entering the lane, dueled outside of the runner up through the drive and wore that one down late to prevail. DEVIL'S WING set the pace from the two path and under pressure to the stretch, dueled inside of the winner through the drive and went willingly to the wire. CHAMPAGNENCASHMERE pressed the pace along the rail to the midstretch but was outfinished late. MARVELOUS MONSTER saved ground racing in midpack to the stretch but did not produce a rally. PNUTBUTTERANDJOLIE was never a factor. ROYAL ILLUSION broke slowly and showed little thereafter. MARLIN DANCE was outrun.
