PRECEPTS TEN broke sharp and dueled early from the inside, made a bid turning for home but had no late rally. OUTLAW AT LARGE stalked the early leaders from the outside, raced four wide in the last turn and had nothing left late. EASYONTHEEYES was outrun early and improved position and finished well. ELEVEN GAGE was always outrun.
