EXCURSION set a contested pace, edged clear into the stretch and held sway under a drive. MR UNTOUCHABLE chased the pace while five wide, lodged a on the bid turn, moved four wide into the stretch and finished well. OUR STATUS QUO stumbled at the start, was pinched soon after, swung six wide into the stretch and managed a late bid. LAKE LUCERNE was outpaced while five wide and exhibited mild late interest. LIMIT THE WAGON stalked the pace, challenged the winner on the turn and weakened in the stretch. BIG DADDYS ARUNNIN bobbled at the start, prompted the pace and dropped back on the turn. SOUTH BRANCH STORM was washy in the post parade and proved no factor. COLD DAWN showed little interest.
