DUKE OF MISCHIEF saved ground, angled off the rail around the far turn, surged to the front and kicked clear in the stretch under solid handling. SOUL WARRIOR prompted the pace, remained inside for the stretch run, proved no match and stayed on in the stretch to secure the place spot. RED LEAD set a moderate pace, was urged on the far turn, got outfinished in the stretch but stayed on to garner a minor share. MOONPORT washy in the post parade, was reserved, entered the stretch three wide and lodged a mild bid. PROCEED BEE outrun early, swung five wide into the stretch and passed tiring rivals. HIS GREATNESS raced forwardly while three wide and weakened. UNO MAS saved ground, angled four wide into the stretch and managed no rally. CONCHACER took no part. TERRAIN settled well, advanced leaving the first turn, was steadied briefly at the five-eighths marker, was pulled up approaching the three-eighths marker and vanned off.
