Footnotes

GOLDEN TRIP set the pace inside of SCOTTISH CROWN around the first turn, went clear on the backstretch, widened around the second turn, continued to increase the margin to the wire while under a moderate hand ride. MISS GALORE raced well back on the backstretch, began advancing along the rail approaching the second turn, angled out four wide approaching the stretch, ran on to gain the distant place. SPENDEMILY saved ground within easy striking range to the second turn, advanced inside rivals entering the stretch, came off the inside in upper stretch, was overtaken late for the place and narrowly held third. HOP TO IT saved ground while well back to the stretch, finished willingly along the rail and just missed third. BLACK TIE QUEEN raced four wide on the first turn, was in midpack throughout and was never a factor. SCOTTISH CROWN chased the winner to the stretch before tiring. SANDRA DI raced within easy striking range while chasing the winner to midway on the second turn, faltered through the lane. SPEND A BUCK BABY and PRUDENCE were both outrun.
