FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box on Tuesday, June 23 \$3,000 additional to start on Saturday, June 27 with \$250,000 guaranteed and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup Nominees only. The Host Association's monies divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth. SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATIONS AT TIME OF ENTRY WITH A FEE OF \$6,000 TO ENTER AND START. Weights: Friday, June 19. Breeders' Cup Fund Monies also correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to fund. Starters to be named through the entry-box by the usual time of closing. The race will not be divided. Preference will be given to Breeders' Cup nominees only of equal weight assignment. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second parts of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The winning owner will receive a trophy from Breeders' Cup Limited.

**Footnotes**

JONESBORO stalked the pace comfortably, was roused at the quarter mile marker, moved three wide into the stretch, responded to firm handling and wore down SHADOWBDANCING. The latter sprinted clear, held well into the stretch, got caught but stayed on gamely against the rail to secure the place spot. MY PAL CHARLIE brushed early, raced in tight quarters at the fifteen-sixteenths marker, settled well, moved three wide into the stretch and kept on for a minor share. VICTORY PETE ducked out sharply approaching the seven-eighths marker hampering rivals, lodged a strong five wide bid around the far turn, moved out six wide into the stretch but came up empty. SECRET GETAWAY awash with sweat in the post parade, raced six wide into the first turn, was outpaced while five wide, had to be urged on the far turn and lacked a rally. STONEHOUSE tried to lean out when squeezed against the rail at the fifteen-sixteenths marker, saved ground and offered no response when called upon. RED HOT N GOLD was checked hard at the seven-eighths marker, lost his position and failed to recover. WAYZATA BAY was checked when hampered at the seven-eighths marker, dropped back and proved no menace thereafter. FOLLOWING THE RACE, THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO A SERIES OF INCIDENTS ENTERING THE FIRST TURN, AFTER REVIEWING VIDEOTAPED REPLAYS, THEY DECIDED TO MAKE NO CHANGES TO THE ORDER OF FINISH.
