The latter settled well while four wide, remained four wide into the stretch and rallied. TESSERACT chased along the inside, remained inside for the stretch run and kept on. MAYBE SOMEDAY BABY gained the lead, was headed leaving the turn and gave way. WHICH SONG was always outrun. MISS UPPER CUT was outpaced and faded. TOMS PRINCESS never menaced. HIGHEST GOOD faltered. TRAVELIN SOLO took no part.
