BLUES AWAY was ridden along early and dueled from between rivals to the stretch, continue to duel outside of the runner up to midstretch before drawing clear late under urging. TRUTHFUL HEART dueled along the rail to midstretch, could not match the winner late but easily held the place. BLAKE RATTLENROLL dueled for the lead racing three wide to the stretch, weakened while failing to switch leads through the drive. VALID PRIME trailed to midstretch before putting in a mild rally without threatening. SCHATZIE DREAMS saved ground racing within striking range to the stretch, did not rally. ONMYGROUNDS raced three wide on the turn and was never a factor. PRIVATE PETETION chased the dueling leaders from the two path to the stretch before giving way. DISAPPEARING was never a factor.
