ROARING MAX reserved early, advanced on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and rallied under steady pressure. BROKEN FREE saved ground, angled out three wide at the furlong marker, stayed on but could not resist the top one's surge. JESS Z gained the early lead, was roused at the quarter mile marker and worn down late under heavy pressure. MASS APPEAL brushed at the start, was steadied when short of room at the seven-sixteenths marker and lacked a rally. JUST A PRINCE stalked the pace, was urged on the turn and faded. DENALI SLEW failed to menace. STORMIN MONKEY displayed brief speed.
