Footnotes

STARLET SKY stalked the pace racing near the inside to midway on the final turn, angled out a bit for racing room approaching the stretch, rallied to challenge a sixteenth out and won going away under left handed pressure. IOWA'S MELANIE raced four wide in midpack on the first turn, made a three wide bid midway on the final turn, fought to a narrow lead approaching the stretch, was overtaken leaving the sixteenth marker and proved second best. SILVIE'S LULLABY raced close up while three wide on the first turn, made a bid outside the pacesetter on the backstretch, dueled between foes on the final turn, weakened through the stretch. C J SIRIUS saved ground within striking range to the stretch and did not rally. LADY SHARK trailed to the final turn and was never a factor. ROYAL LADY raced four wide while being outrun on the final turn. PARDON MY HEART raced three wide while well back on the first turn, made a four wide bid outside rivals on the final turn but failed to sustain her run and gave way through the stretch. DIRECT SHOT set the pace from the rail, dueled inside rivals on the final turn before tiring through the stretch.
