MORE THAN REGAL saved ground tracking the pace to the stretch, switched off the rail in upper stretch, rallied to collar the runner up in the final seventy yards and prevailed under urging. BLAZING SUNSET established the pace and was well rated while racing without pressure to the stretch, maintained his advantage to midstretch, continued willingly but was caught late. WAIT IN LINE chased the pacesetter from the two path to the stretch, finished evenly and held third. CIRCLE THE WORLD trailed on the first turn, raced within range near the back of the field in the two path on the far turn, finished evenly along the rail. ELECTRIFY raced four wide in midpack on the first turn, remained within range and four deep on the final turn, went evenly through the lane. SPOTSGONE raced close up while three wide to the stretch before weakening. KINGSFIELD showed little.
