UPTOWN BERTIE reserved early, made a three wide advance on the far turn, surged clear into the stretch and held on well thereafter under steady encouragement. ICE CREAM SILENCE chased along the inside, angled out three wide into the stretch and finished well. EMONA void of speed, commenced her bid around the far turn, angled in nearing the furlong marker, rallied greenly and was gaining. LIVI MAKENZIE gained the early lead, was challenged on the far turn and gave way. TAPAJO settled well between rivals, stalked the pacesetter into the far turn and lacked a rally. IZE IN TROUBLE leaned in at the start, raced forwardly while four wide and faltered.
