Footnotes

TRIP stalked the pace while racing three wide, moved up to take a narrow advantage without being asked approaching the stretch, dueled outside of LADY MELESI through the lane before inching clear late under an aggressive hand ride. LADY MELESI pressed the pace inside of FIESTY COUNTESS while under a hold to the second turn, responded willingly when asked approaching the stretch, fought hard inside of the winner through the lane but could not match strides late while easily besting the rest. FIESTY COUNTESS set the pace under pressure while racing in the two path to the second turn, was challenged on both sides midway around that bend and weakened. ANNUAL RAINFALL vied for the lead along the rail early, took back into a stalking position around the first turn, was angled off the rail while racing close up on the backstretch, remained within easy striking range to the stretch before weakening. WILD WON was outrun. NUT N BETTER raced within striking range to the second turn before faltering. NORTHERN SUMMER was outrun.
