WHIMSY settled off the early leaders, saved ground tracking the pacesetters to midway on the final turn, angled out three wide entering the stretch, rallied to the front in upper stretch and went clear, prevailed under urging. CEE'S IRISH raced three wide outside rivals and tracking the pace for the first half mile, made a brief bid outside foes entering the final turn, couldn't match strides and slipped back a bit while four wide on the bend, re rallied through the lane, was eased up on in the final fifty yards after she had secured the place and couldn't catch the winner. MARY ALEX set the pace racing in hand and without pressure to the final turn, was headed approaching the stretch, weakened through the final furlong but saved third. GALACTIC CAT tracked MARY ALEX from the two path to the final turn, bid outside that rival midway on the bend, couldn't keep pace in upper stretch and weakened. QUEANSCO raced between the top pair on the backstretch before giving way on the final turn.
