Footnotes

NOTTAGRAY stalked the pace racing three wide on the turn, rallied under left handed urging through the lane and collared the runner up late to prevail. CHEER GIRL raced close up outside rivals in the second flight on the backstretch, bid outside a rival approaching the stretch, inched clear in midstretch, continued willingly but was caught late. LADY HIGH INDY came through inside rivals to challenge for the early lead, went clear a half mile out, was headed by the runner up approaching the stretch, weakened through the final furlong. STARLET SKY saved ground racing within easy striking range on the turn, failed to produce a late bid. HAYLEY GO BLUE broke slowly and raced well off the pace to the stretch, finished evenly and passed tired foes. BLANCHETTA chased from the two path to the stretch before weakening. FAITH KEEPER raced four wide on the turn and was never a factor. FARRAR was ridden along and vied for the lead from between rivals early, dropped back on the turn and faltered.
