Footnotes

RUBY SURPRISE stalked the pacesetters to the second turn, rallied entering the lane and moved up to head LINES OF BEAUTY in midstretch, wore that one down through the final furlong to prevail under steady left handed urging. The latter set the pace under pressure from RUNAWAY VENUS to the second turn, shook that one off and went clear around that bend, was headed by the winner leaving the furlong marker, continued willingly inside of that rival but could not quite match strides late while well clear of the rest. KEEP ME SAFE was taken back early, passed tired rivals to gain the distant show. REFLECT THE MUSIC advanced to race in midpack on the backstretch but was never a factor. ADAM'S TIME showed little. SUNNIE DO IT was in a bit tight while between horses entering the first turn, dropped over to the rail early on that bend, dropped back on the backstretch. SIBLING SONG was outrun. RUNAWAY VENUS moved up to press the pace outside of LINES OF BEAUTY entering the backstretch, couldn't keep pace with that one entering the second turn, drifted out entering the stretch and tired badly.
